Ontario law is clear, employers are required to provide health and safety information, instruction and in many cases training. Too often though, training is sorely inadequate or absent altogether. This is especially the case in **vulnerable populations** such as migrant workers, immigrant workers, gig workers and workers in smaller workplaces.

Workers Health & Safety Centre, Ontario's only labour-endorsed, government-designated health and safety training provider is working to bridge this gap. But **we need your help** to spread the word and where possible sponsor training events.

### ELIGIBILITY

Special one-time funding from the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development allows us to offer training at a modest cost, or even at no cost in some cases, for a limited time. Eligible individuals and organizations are those who work in, run, or receive services from charities, non-governmental organizations and non-profit organizations, including **unions and labour councils**. Workplaces employing less than 50 workers also qualify.

### NO-COST OPTIONS

If you want to train a larger number and can supply a suitable training venue, or a Zoom account, we can bring any of these training programs to your union or labour council at no cost.

If you already work with the United Way, women's shelters, immigrant settlement or similar organizations, please consider helping them access our training offer. Work with us to sponsor this training at your union hall. Depending on the program, perhaps have them train alongside your members in combined classes. Let's show our communities in a very tangible way that we care.
